FABRIC REQUIREMENT:

Fabrics from series „Icy Winter”, 44”(112 cm) wide.



OTHER SUPPLIES:

Batting: Matilda's own 99M400 100% cotton 95" (2,4 m) wide 63" (160 cm)

In addition: Matching sewing and quilting thread.

CUTTING ➡:

¼" (0,75 cm) seam allowance is included.

IMPORTANT WHEN SEWING BY HAND:

When cutting the templates 2, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 10 pls. cut away the lines so the final squares will end up having the same size as template 1. Also cut away lines on template 4 & 9 so they will fit template 3.

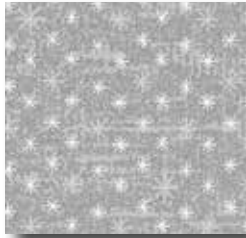

SEWING OF QUILT TOP: Seam allowance is 1/4" (0,75 cm).

Assembly block 1-12 according to lay outs on page 6-11, using template from page 12-13.

Afterwards join block 1-3 in a row. Next Block 4-6, block 7-9 & block 10-12, also see lay out page 4.

At last join these rows together and the quilt piece is created.

NOTE: Some of the squares with triangles can be made with quick half square triangles and quick double half square triangles, see over view on page 5.

QUILTING AND BINDING:

Layer top, batting and backing in fabric I and baste the pieces.

Quilt as you prefer by hand or by machine ➡.

Sew hanging sleeve in fabric I and place under top binding in fabric G ➡.

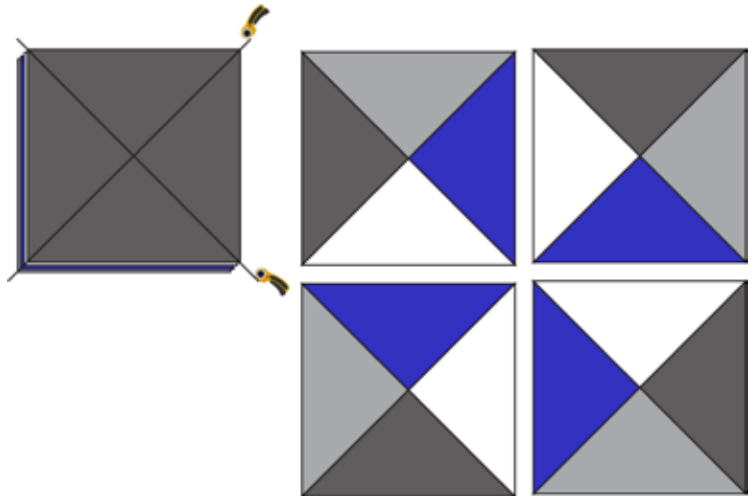
HOW TO USE QUICK HALF SQUARES METHOD ON TEMPLATE 2, 4 & 10:

Template 2:

Cut squares 15,5 x 15,5 cm for all four fabrics in the square & cut twice.

Overview of which fabrics & how many squares:

B: 2 squares C: 1 square
E: 1 square F: 1 square
G: 1 square H: 2 squares

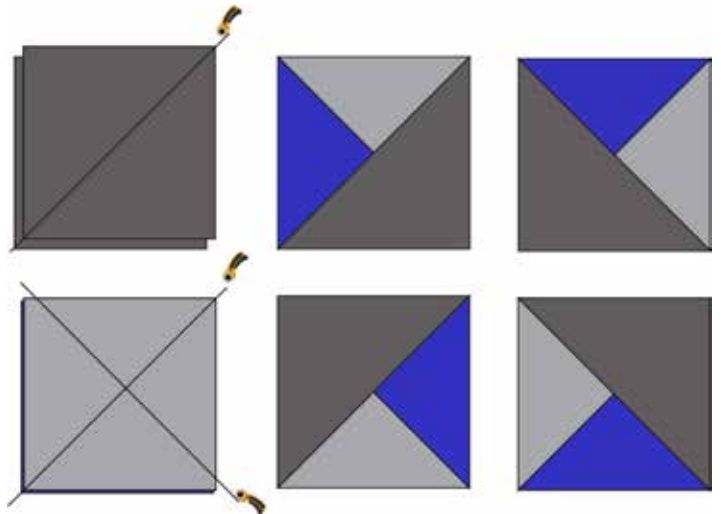


Template 2 & 10:

Cut 2 squares 14,5 x 14,5 cm in fabric with biggest triangle. Cut ones.
And cut 1 square 15,5 x 15,5 cm in other two fabrics. Cut twice.

Overview of which fabrics & how many squares:

D: 2 squares (cut ones)
F: 2 squares (cut ones)
B: 1 square (cut twices)
E: 1 square (cut twices)
G: 1 square (cut twices)
H: 1 square (cut twices)

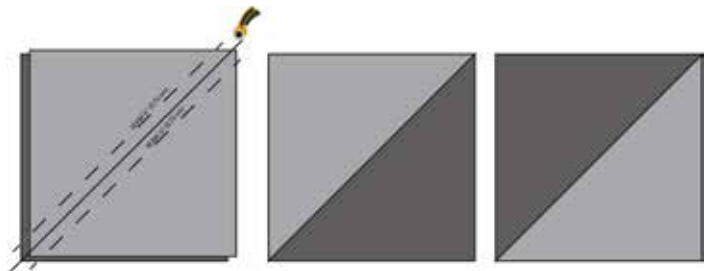


Template 4:

Cut squares 11,5 x 11,5 cm.
Draw a diagonal line at top square and sew twice on each side of line with seam allowance 1/4" (0,75 cm).
Cut at line.

Overview of which fabrics & how many squares:

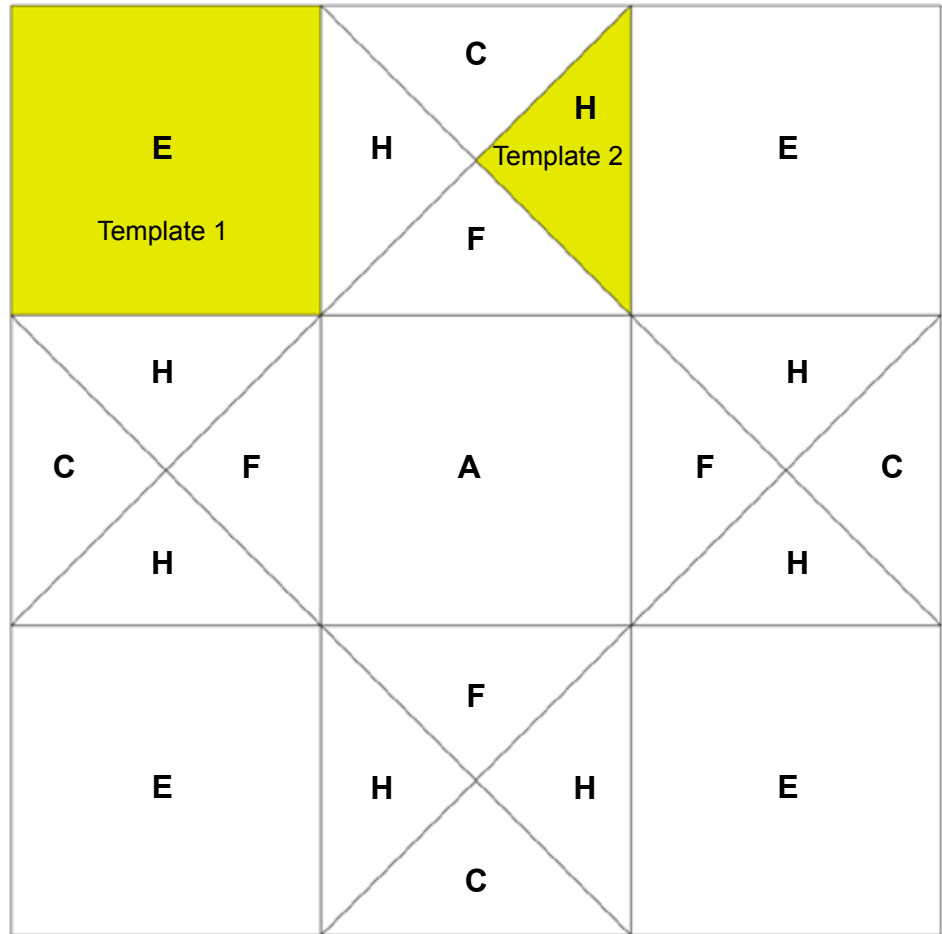
A: 12 squares B: 12 squares
C: 8 squares D: 4 squares
E: 6 squares F: 4 squares
G: 10 squares H: 4 squares



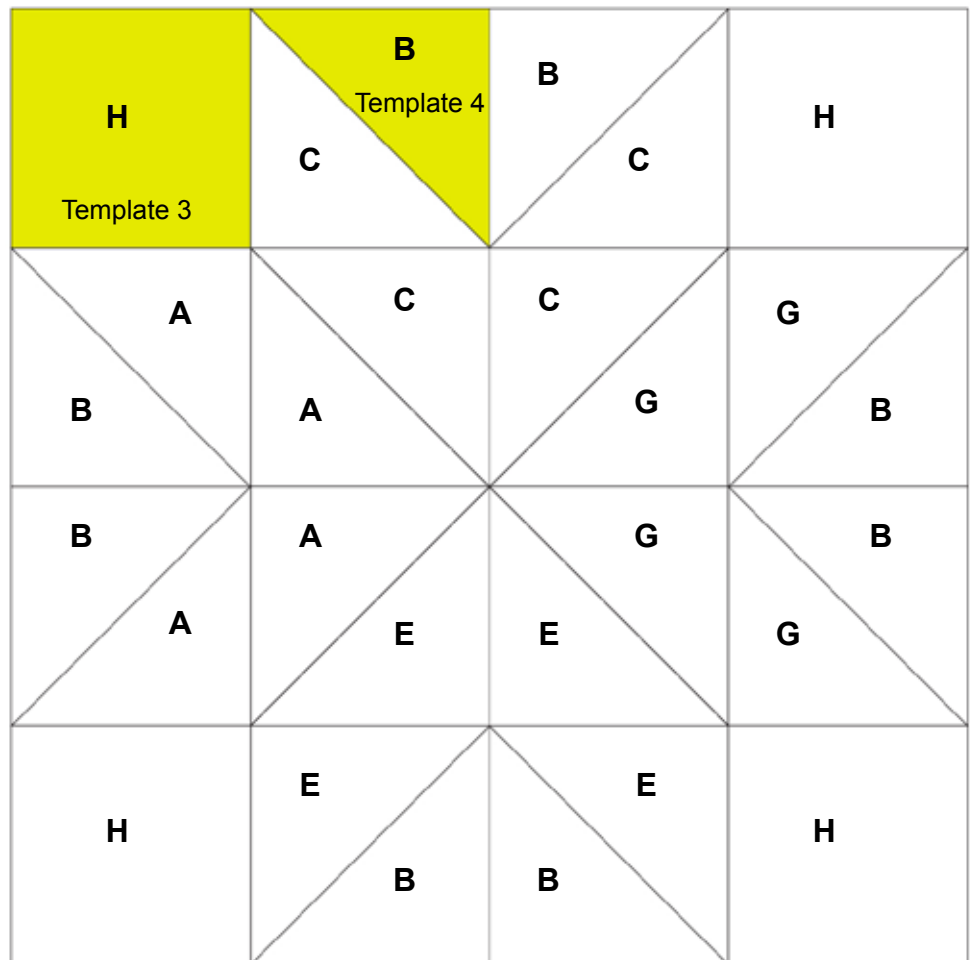
IMPORTANT:

If you chose this easier way to sew the squares you need to take away the amount of triangles which concerns template 2,4 & 10 on page 1 & 2. For instance fabric A - template 4: the 24 triangles are replaced with 12 squares.

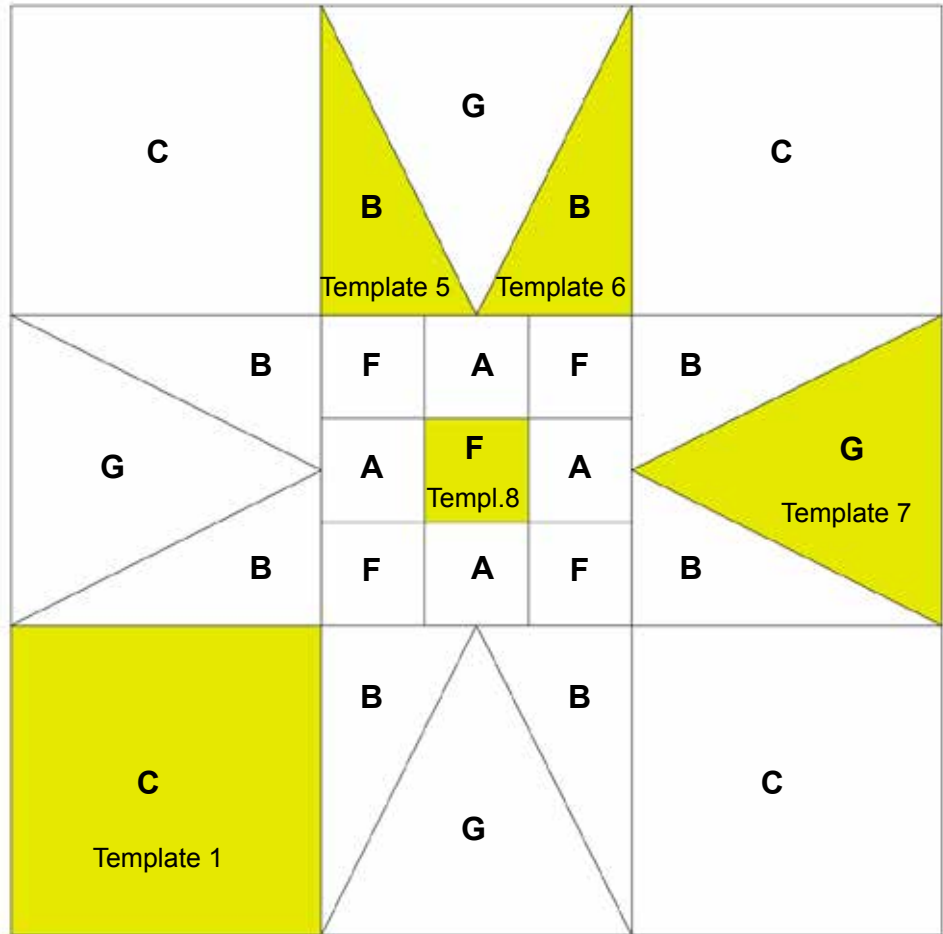

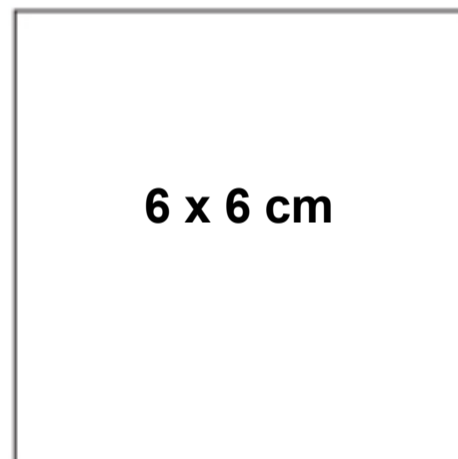
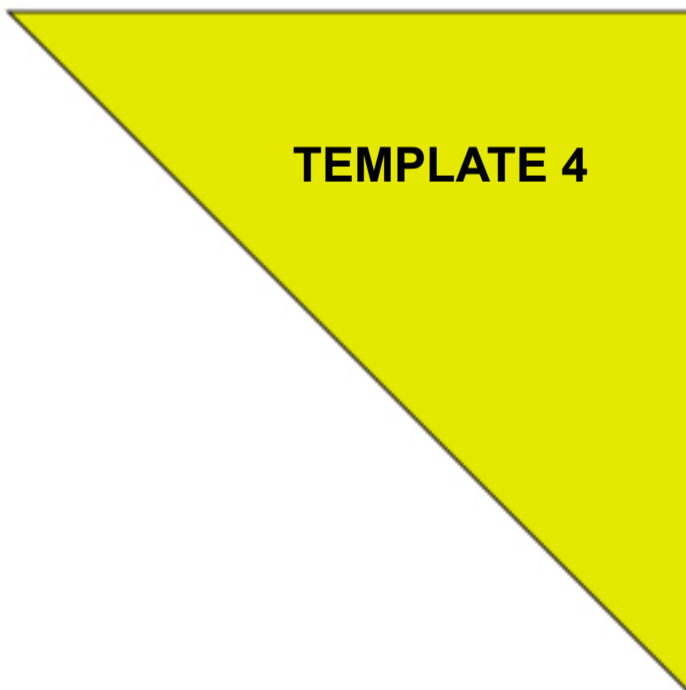
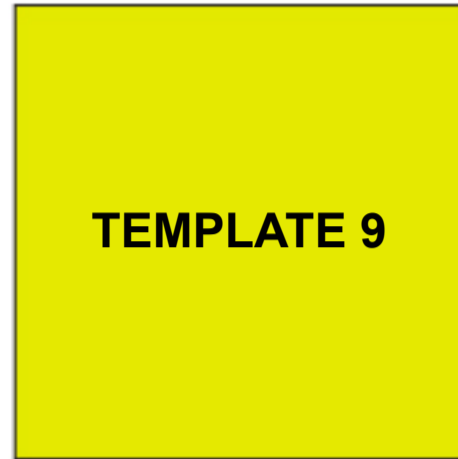
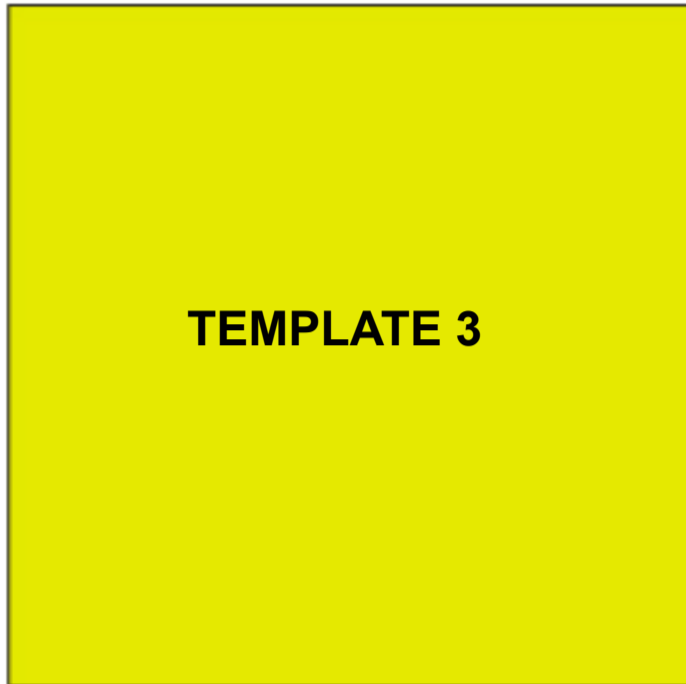
TEMPLATES FOR 9 PATCH STARS
